Your consent applies to any Disclosure provided to you and any Change in Terms Notice. In order to properly deliver your regular statements and any disclosures from time to time, you must update us with any change in your e-mail address. You can withdraw your consent to receive electronic statements and disclosures by calling us or writing to us at the number or address listed below, or by notifying us in person.

In order to receive and view the disclosures and e-statements electronically, the following minimum computer hardware and software requirements must be met: Internet-capable device with access to an updated browser program at least 128-bit encryption (i.e. Microsoft Edge, Firefox, Google Chrome, Safari etc.); Access to an updated version of Adobe Acrobat Reader 10.0 or greater which will allow you to view PDF files; Valid operating e-mail address and software to access e-mail; Printer capable of printing any communications that are e-mailed to you and/or made available on our website; Ability to visually display on your device any communications that are e-mailed to you and/or made available on our website; Sufficient memory and drive space capacity to download and/or save to your device documents and other communications e-mailed to you or made available on our website.

### **E-STATEMENT PROCESS**

With receipt of the E-Statement Authorization, your account statement will be changed from paper format to electronic format. Each time your statement is produced you will be sent an e-mail to the above provided e-mail address indicating that your statement has been prepared and is ready. You will create your own username and password through csiesafe.com to access the statement (establishing a secure username and password limits viewing of the statement information by an unauthorized individual who may otherwise be able to view all other e-mail items). If you want to receive your statements electronically through Online or Mobile Banking (where an e-mail will be sent to you notifying you that your statements are ready and you will access them through Online or Mobile Banking), you will need to log in to Online Banking to select the statement and notices you would like to receive electronically and accept the terms and conditions. Once you are receiving your statements electronically, you will no longer receive these items in paper format. In order to ensure the accuracy of the e-mail address provided, a test e-mail will be sent to you prior to receiving an actual statement or notice the first time.
